NEWSUN ENERGY TRANSMISSION COMPANY LLC

Pursuant to the notice appearing in the Federal Register Vol. 88, No. 214 on November 7, 2023, and Rule 1010.6 of the Bonneville Power Administration’s (BPA) Rules of Procedure (September 12, 2018), NewSun Energy Transmission Company LLC (NewSun) respectfully petitions to intervene as a party in this proceeding. NewSun provides the following:

I. BACKGROUND

NewSun is a Delaware limited liability company that is a transmission customer of BPA and thus “directly purchase[s] power or transmission services under Bonneville’s rate schedules.” BPA Rules of Procedure § 1010.6(b). BPA is holding this proceeding to implement changes to BPA’s Large Generator Interconnection Procedures under its Open Access Transmission Tariff, and thus this proceeding will likely result in changes to the terms and conditions of interconnection and transmission service offered to existing and prospective customers.

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III. PETITION TO INTERVENE

NewSun is a transmission customer of BPA and thus is eligible to intervene in this proceeding as an entity that “directly purchase[s] power or transmission services under Bonneville’s rate schedules.” BPA Rules of Procedure § 1010.6(b). More generally, because this proceeding will likely result in changes to the terms and conditions on which NewSun may obtain interconnection and transmission service from BPA, NewSun has a substantial interest in and will be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding. NewSun’s interests would not be adequately represented by any other party to this proceeding. NewSun therefore respectfully requests that the BPA grant this Petition to Intervene.
